

#### **Useful Land Measurements for Genealogists**

1 chain = 66 feet, or 100 links, or 4 poles, rods or perches

1 link = 7.92 inches, or 1/100 of a 66 foot chain

1 pole, rod or perch = 25 links, or 16.5 feet

1 square pole, rod or perch = 272 1/4 square feet

1 acre = 160 square poles, rods or perches

1 acre = 10 square chains, or 43,560 square feet

1 mile = 80 chains, or 5,280 feet

1 square mile = 640 acres
