Mary's Book Corner

The Prussian Captain by Ann Brough is a special book. It is romantic historical fiction with a touch of family saga and class conflict. So, what does it have to do with genealogy? A couple of years ago a woman in Canada contacted the Society looking for help in researching her great grandfather's connection to Napa. As a part of our paid research service I found some deeds, vital records, and newspaper stories about him. She and her husband made a trip to the Bay Area and visited the property which he held in Wild Horse Valley and two other very large parcels in Sonoma County. It was a delight to meet them and share her enthusiasm for the information that I had found. Last fall I received an email from her nephew announcing that his mother, her sister, was finishing up a novel about the family. It is all about the great grandfather, Francis Wrightson, and centers on the story of one of his sons, Edgar (Edward in the book). It is the best kind of historical novel, using all the primary sources; vital records, census returns, deeds, newspaper accounts, wills, and protracted probate proceedings as the foundation of the story. It is fully fleshed out by creating personalities and dialogue. One delight was the thorough research that went into describing how a large well-todo family would travel between England and Napa in 1877. I was provided a pre-publication eBook but it will go into general release on September 12, 2017. Be sure to look for it!



Sassy Jane Genealogy (https://www.sassyjanegenealogy.com/place-research-tool-for-genealogy-research) introduced a new Places tool from Family Search located at this website: https://familysearch.org/research/places/

With a large database of useful place related websites, you will be able to find links to GPS-generated maps, variant spellings, and changes to place names over time, timeline and most excitedly links to area research.

I first tried a county that had only a history timeline. Next I tried Butler County Ohio and found basic info as to county origin, statistics from last census, sites with info on Butler as well as a map. I chose the option, "Search for Records on this Place at FamilySearch." Then I chose Collections tab after narrowing down my search to a time period in the Search box to narrow. A name can be added also. I also searched for County Cork Ireland. Then I spent an hour searching info. How time flies when we are having fun.

Now the other big news from FamilySearch is that microfilm ordering will be discontinued as they are including nearly all of the images online. "On September 1, 2017, FamilySearch will discontinue its microfilm distribution services. (The last day to order microfilm will be on August 31, 2017.) The change is the result of significant progress in FamilySearch's microfilm digitization efforts and the obsolescence of microfilm technology." From familysearch.org website.
