A MESSAGE FROM YOUR BOARD


The society serves as a medium to share knowledge through workshops and educa-

## Keep those plastic bottles and tin cans coming, all those refunds go to the NVGS fund raising account.


Mary's Book Corner

**North Carolina** <u>http://digital.ncdcr.gov/</u> Wow, clicking on Collections produced quite a list to explore. <u>https://www.digitalnc.org/</u> Browse any collections on the left or all collections at bottom of screen.

**North Dakota** <u>http://digitalhorizonsonline.org/digital/</u> Saw Town Histories and I was already impressed. Several collections to explore.

**Ohio** <u>http://www.ohiomemory.org</u> As always choosing Collections is a good way to start. If overwhelmed, go to Places and select a county and do a search from there.

**Oklahoma** <u>https://digital.libraries.ou.edu/cdm/</u> mostly useful on Native American Research. <u>https://www.okhistory.org/research/index</u> This appeals to broader researching.

**Oregon** <u>https://sos.oregon.gov/archives/Pages/records.aspx</u> A good example of a Secretary of State site for research!
